## **LEADER AGREEMENT**

## To be signed by the primary group leader who will be present throughout your stay at The Vineyard.

The Vineyard desires that all guests have a safe, fun time, & that all are drawn closer to the Lord. To these ends, the following guidelines are provided. These guidelines are very serious & need to be fully understood & adhered to by everyone in your group. Signing this agreement attests to the fact that you <u>understand</u> these guidelines, will <u>brief all</u> members of your group, & will <u>enforce</u> these guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure compliance. If you can not ensure compliance, do not sign this agreement - it should be signed by someone who can. Please keep a copy of this agreement for use when briefing your group. Failure to abide by these guidelines could result in withheld deposits, additional charges, expulsion, or being barred from returning.

## 1. A mature, responsible adult must supervise all activities in which non-adults participate.

- 2. Pets are not permitted on Vineyard property. There is a \$225 fee for pets found inside our facilities.
- 3. Lifejackets must be WORN by ALL participants in boating activity, <u>no exceptions</u>.
- 4. Pool rules: 1) no pushing, diving, running, or horseplay in pool area 2) no food or drinks in pool area 3) modest swimming apparel to be worn [see dress standard below] 4) no earrings, bracelets, or necklaces allowed in pool 5) do not play with or alter pool equipment 6) shower before entering pool 7) rinse feet before each re-entry into pool 8) swim at your own risk there is no lifeguard provided 9) use pool only when conditions are safe to do so.
- 5. Please ensure that everyone in your group dresses according to conservative Christian standards:
  - No 2-piece bikinis unless covered by a colored shirt.
  - No public display of private areas including belly buttons (applicable to males and females).
  - No public display of underwear including boxer shorts and bras.
  - The Vineyard reserves the right to restrict any clothing deemed inappropriate.
- 6. Leave spiders, snakes, and other wildlife alone. Report anything dangerous to Vineyard staff.
- 7. Guests staying in the Conference Center and Lake Lodge need to bring their own bed linens and towels.
- 8. Upon arrival at The Vineyard, please note the location of all furnishings including beds, chairs, couches, pianos, and audiovisual equipment. Before departure, please return *all* furnishings to original location.
- 9. If preparing your own meals bring your own supplies (oil, spray, paper towels, etc) including charcoal (if grilling). Have designated kitchen staff and keep non kitchen staff out of kitchen in the Conference Center. Also, please ensure that all kitchen and meal trash is taken to our dumpster after each meal.
- 10. When the Vineyard staff prepares meals, there are some food items that are self-serve. Sufficient servings will be provided to accommodate your group (with some seconds included), however it is your responsibility to ensure the first few members don't get it all and leave none for the remaining members.
- 11. The Vineyard store is available any time upon request.
- 12. The equipment room, storage rooms, pool house, and maintenance areas are for Vineyard staff only.
- 13. Do not alter safety equipment in any way, unless necessary for an emergency.

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- 14. Use water balloons, water guns, spray shaving cream, silly string, or other messy stuff outside only.
- 15. The gym is for organized activities only no free-for-all wild crazy stuff. <u>Do not allow balls near gym</u> <u>ceiling and/or lights.</u> Foam footballs are permitted in gym, other style footballs are not.
- 16. The Recreational Building may only be used while a mature, responsible adult is present. No food or drinks allowed in Rec. Building. Please do not move game tables.
- 17. All Vineyard property is tobacco, vape, alcohol, and illegal drug free.
- 18. No secular music or secular videos allowed on Vineyard grounds.
- 19. Closed-toe style athletic shoes are required for Team Obstacle Course use.
- 20. Please park in designated parking areas only. Do not park or drive on grass.
- 21. Please do not use any tape stickier than masking tape on walls or floors. No Duck (or duct) tape.
- 22. If your group wishes to use the roller racers, please ensure all participants abide by the printed roller racer instructions a copy of which may be obtained by asking a member of the Vineyard staff.
- 23. If the Vineyard front entrance automated gate needs to be opened or closed during your stay at the Vineyard, please ensure that all members of your group follow the printed instructions for safe use of the gate a copy of these instructions may be acquired by asking a member of the Vineyard staff.
- 24. Any individual(s) behaving in an unsafe manner or in a manner which is inconsiderate of others may be asked by Vineyard staff not to participate in a particular activity or asked to leave Vineyard property.
- 25. You are responsible for injuries/damage caused by poor supervision or failure to follow these guidelines.
- 26. Our staff conducts daily maintenance checks. Please notify us if anything is needed anytime.
- 27. Deposits can be withheld for unnecessary littering or damage to Vineyard property.
- 28. Some facilities are shared. Please maintain a positive attitude toward sharing with other groups.
- 29. Please leave time in your schedule to conduct a damage/cleanliness inspection of buildings and grounds with a Vineyard employee and time to correct any deficiencies, before departure from the Vineyard.
- 30. **Typically, check-in time is no earlier than 1:00 p.m. and check-out time in no later than 11:00 a.m.** although other arrangements can be made if there are no conflicts with other groups. If you need to alter these times, please request other times. Please adhere to arrival times and departure times you request.
- 31. Guests' personal property may be confiscated by Vineyard Staff if found to be unsafe or outside these guidelines.
